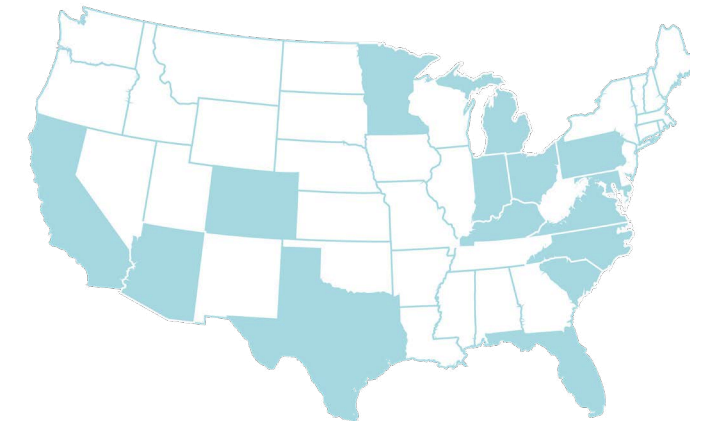

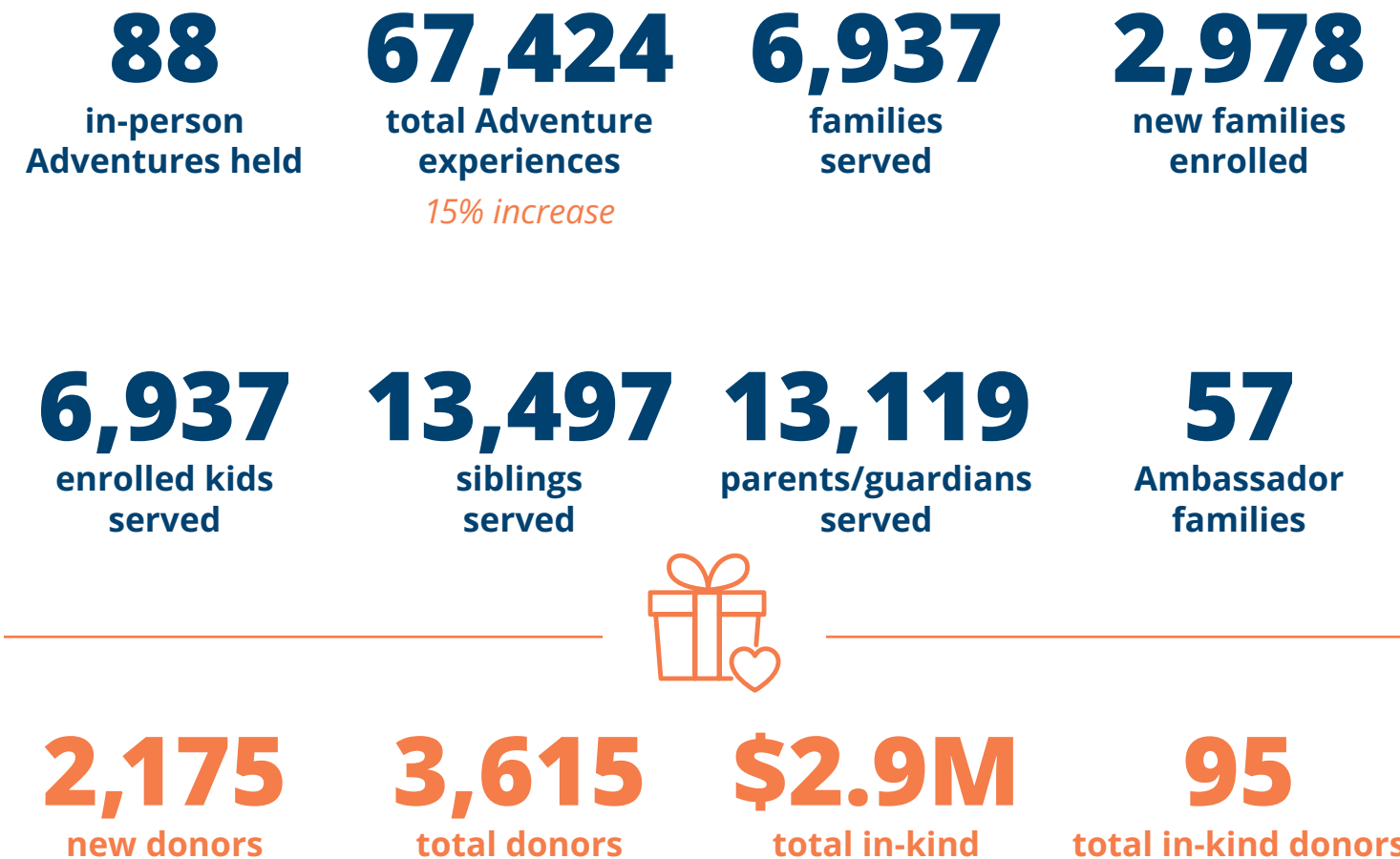

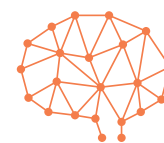

Born at 24 weeks and living with cerebral palsy and epilepsy, Paisley had faced more than her share of scary moments. But at A Kid Again, she found something else: anticipation, joy, and connection.

She couldn't wait to leap from her wheelchair—not away from fear, but toward friendship. For the first time, she met someone who understood. Someone just like her.

Since then, Elizabeth has become an active behind-the-scenes volunteer, wrapping Christmas gifts, sorting donations, and supporting the team.

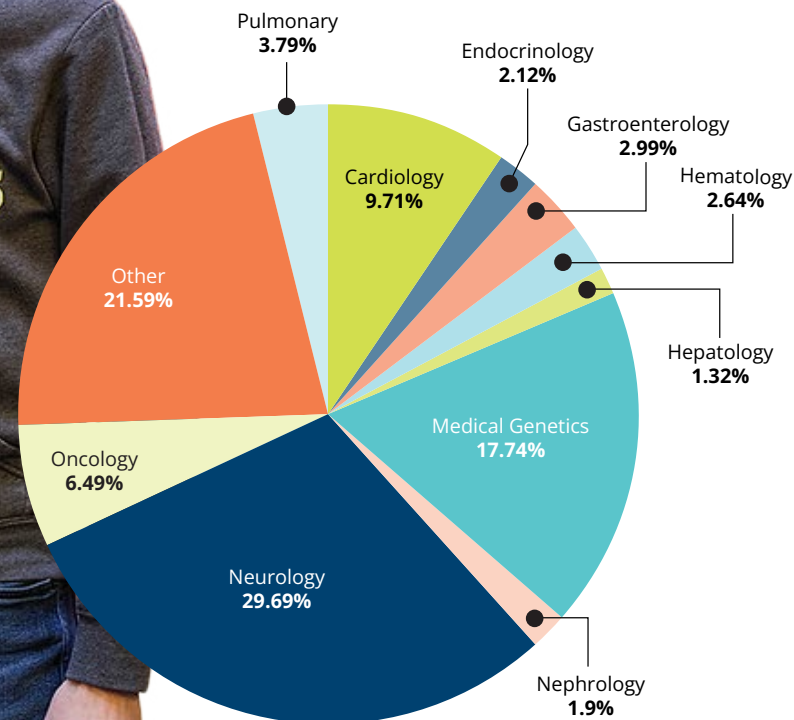

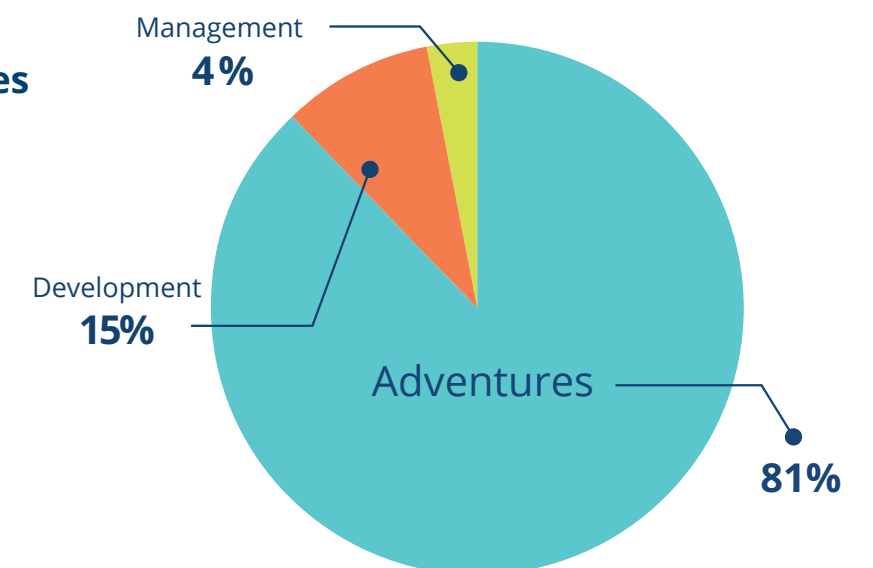
